

Policy: Requirements for Continuing Education and Competency for Expired and Suspended Registrants

Relevant Legislation and Regulation: RHPA Section 60, Continuing education requirement, RHPA Section 22, Eligibility for renewal, RHPA Section 24, Application for reinstatement, and RHPA Section 25, Suspension or cancellation of registration.

Policy

- 1.1 While Registrants who have an expired status are not subject to the Audit Selection Criteria and Reporting Requirements of Registrants for Continuing Education and Competency Audits policy, they are still expected to maintain currency and records if they plan to return to practice as a Technologist or Therapist.
- 1.2 Registrants who have a suspended status, or conditions or restrictions on their registration, are subject to the Audit Selection Criteria and Reporting Requirements of Registrants for Continuing Education and Competency Audits.
- 1.3 A Registrant who is seeking reinstatement of a lapsed registration must demonstrate that their learning plan and learning activities, including credit hours are current as a requirement of reinstatement.
- 1.4 A Registrant who is seeking reinstatement of registration after a suspension of registration is required to demonstrate to the Registrar that their learning plan, learning activities, and credit hours obligations are up to date as a requirement of reinstatement.
